

Health, Safety and Environment Management System (HSE MS) Scope

Murowa Diamonds explores, mines and processes diamondiferous ore to recover diamonds for local and international markets. The Mine Site is located at GPS position 20° South and 30° East, while the Harare Office is located at 1 Kenilworth road, Kenilworth Gardens, Newlands, Harare. The EMS and OH&S scope covers hazards/aspects and impacts/risks related to the organisation's activities, processes, products and services which are internally and externally provided at both Mine Site and Harare Office.

The HSE MS Scope takes into consideration the following:

- Compliance with relevant legal and other requirements during implementation of the HSE MS
- Internal and external issues relevant to the HSE MS purpose
- Needs and expectations of workers and other interested parties that are relevant to the HSE MS
- HSE MS's ability and authority to exercise control and influence
- Planned or performed work-related activities


Mine Site facilities include:

- Exploration activities as part of surface mining development process
- Surface mining operation consisting of 3 pits namely K1; K2 and K3
- Process Plant [Run of Mine (ROM) pad, mobile crushing plant, fixed crushing plant, exploration plant, dense media separation and recovery plant]
- Maintenance facility consisting of workshops and equipment wash down facilities
- Tailings dam
- Administration Block
- Clinic (Medical centre)
- Security Access Control Blocks (Tier 1 & 2)
- Mine village
- Landfill and other waste handling facilities
- Silt dams (Gute and Tekwe)
- Fresh water and wastewater storage and treatment facilities
- Airstrip
- Stores, emulsion storage, lubricant storage, fuel farm and salvage yard
- Future infrastructure site (Area B)

Harare Office facilities include:

- Diamond Sorting section and
- Administration Offices
